FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Next weekend, at the parish masses, children enrolled in the Faith Formation Program at Saint Augustine-Saint Francis Xavier will be receiving Holy Communion for the first time. **17** children have been prepared by their parents: the first teachers of our faith, as well as by volunteer catechists and by the Parish Staff members responsible for this important task. As a parish community too, we have helped to continue to form those who are now able to receive Holy Communion after sufficient preparation. Our prayerful participation at Mass gives witness to the importance of what we do as we pray each week.

This provides an excellent opportunity for us all to remember that we demonstrate to those being formed the need to seek the sacrament of confession when we are not in a state of grace. If we are intentional in our desire to follow Jesus, and give witness to His Resurrection, then if we fall short, we must seek reconciliation with the people of God through confession and penance. 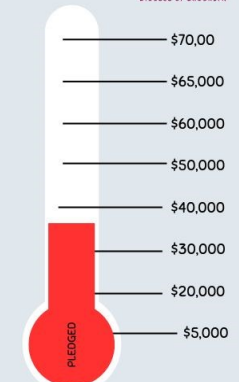
